Preamble: Swastava cancer care which was established in the year 2017 with a bunch of members who are directly or indirectly affected by Cancer with the objective of filling the gap by creating awareness among rural public on cervical, Breast & oral cancer which are high in Telangana. Since formation of the state, efforts are being put by Govt of Telangana, supported by TDF USA in creating medical infrastructure in all the Districts and Swastava has been organizing screening of women for the above cancers and helping them medical facilities, support further investigations till diagnosis to enable them to get admitted where ever Arogya Shree is applicable. Secondly with Rotary, Swastava has taken up vaccinating girl children in the age group of 9 to 14 with 4 variant HPV vaccine under their programme "SAVE NEXT GENERATION FROM **CERVICAL CANCER"**

A flagship programme REACH THEM YOUNG designed to educate Govt school Children on Tobacco & Cancer for classes 8,9 & 10, segregate girl children and educate them on Menstrual Hygiene, Personal Hygiene, and problems of HPV

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Swastava Cancer Care has taken up a new project for Implementation "Geriatric Patient transit home to elderly patients' 'who have to come all the way to Hyderabad from distant districts for chemotherapy and radiation therapy and other procedures.

It is an accepted fact that senior citizens in the family do not get proper attention and are neglected and thus they do not turn up for the second chemo or radiation and they perish. Swastava Cancer care intends to house them (20 to 25 patients along with an attendant), provide free stay & free food and take them for chemotherapy and radiation therapy to the designated hospitals and bring them back.

Swastava has a four-seater Maruti Van gifted by Sri T.R. Reddy from Georgia in his personal capacity, and we are finding it not enough to carry Doctors, Nurses, Screening material and Swastava staff to screening camps and awareness camps in various locations and engaging private transport proving uneconomical.

Swastava requested TDF-USA to consider donating a 13-seater Force van so that the team can move as a single group and be more cost effective. TDF-USA has kindly considered donating a van and so this MOU.

Duties and Responsibilities of Swastava Cancer Care:

- Assume responsibility of all registration formalities and insurance of the vehicle.
- Co-Branding with TDF-USA design, to be approved by TDF-USA before branding the vehicle.
- Swastava shall use it only for official purposes during the camps to various districts in Telangana.
- Swastava shall ensure that this van will not be used for commercial purpose or for family visits.
- Maintenance and upkeep shall be the responsibility of Swastava Cancer Care.
- Cost of fuel and driver remuneration shall be met from out of projects.
- Whenever any EC Member of TDF-USA visits Hyderabad, shall have the privilege of seeing the van in operation and visit the camp sites.
- Swastava will be responsible for the safety of the vehicle and will find a safe parking place.
- Renewal of insurance of the vehicle shall be responsibility of Swastava Cancer Care.

Responsibilities of TDF-USA:

 Procurement, Registration of the vehicle in the name of Swastava Cancer Care after the payment of full charges for lifetime tax and three years insurance.

 Whenever any member visits Hyderabad to inform the General Secretary so that the visit could be organized to see the vehicle in

operation and a campsite.

 Consider sponsoring some school Health programs which are priority for both Telangana and TDF-USA as discussed.

- Support Swastava which is already funded by Novartis for some awareness & screening programmes through finding some more international agencies to fund planned projects to cover other districts in Telangana.
- Agree to Promote and Sponsor the "REACH THEM YOUNG" awareness
 Project designed to educate Govt school Children on Tobacco & Cancer for classes 8,9 and 10 in Government schools in Telangana.
