Memorandum of Understanding

This MOU is between:

Swastava Cancer Care -NGO Hyderabad represented by Dr Chaturvedi CEO, here in after known as SCC

AND

Sri Madhusudan Sai Institute of Medical Sciences and Research, Muddenahalli Represented by Dr. Raghupathi – Director – Hereinafter Known as SMSIMSR

Preamble:

Over 8 years Swastava cancer care has gained enough experience on Community cancer prevention through Creating awareness & screening for Cervical, Breast & Oral cancers. SCC has obtained several state of art equipment for mass screening like Smart scope & Colposcope which work on AI, Thermal Ablation to treat pre cancer lesions and Indian cancer society in which SCC s an affiliate has given Cancer detection van which has Digital Mammogram & Digital X ray which are connected to Tele Radiology.

On cancer awareness, SCC developed good literature for distribution, several videos with expert doctors like surgical oncologists, Gyenic oncologists and Music therapists, which are uploaded to YouTube making available to public and thus help in prevention of cancer.

Over 8 years SCC has screened over 50,000 women in Telangana & Karnataka, helped over 20000 through medication and diagnostic investigations and admitted in MNJ cancer hospital for procedures. 45,000 youth empowered through education on Tobacco & cancer besides vaccinating 1500 boys & girls with HPV vaccine to save next generation from HPV related cancers.

Sri Madhusudan Sai Institute of Medical Sciences and Research -SMSIMSR has now decided to take up cancer awareness & screening and started pilot activities with PAP smear and clinical examination of Breast and accepted the request from SCC to collaborate and work together in Karnataka & Telangana and formally inaugurate on 23 November and so this MOU.

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Responsibilities of SCC:

- 1. Sharing literature, brand them with SMSIMSR & SCC logos
- 2. Cancer detection van will be shifted and kept with SMSIMSR , train their technicians on using Mammogram & X-ray unit.
- 3. The vehicle will be branded with logos od SCC & SMSIMSR suitably
- 4. SCC will organise two camps and thus train the team that works on Awareness & screening.
- 5. Plan programmes in Karnataka & Telangana jointly with SMSIMSR
- 6. Swastava website to have a page for joint activity with SMSIMSR and reciprocated by SMSIMSR in their website
- 7. Share all vehicle documents needed to use on regular basis by SMSIMSR
- 8. Swastava may initiate some research projects with its R&D committee which may be done jointly once Ethics committee of Swastava agrees to.

Responsibilities of SMSIMSR:

- 1. Vehicle maintenance, payment of annual all India tax
- 2. Maintenance of equipment with AMC, etc.
- 3. Utilize mammogram as per the norms of WHO (women who are less than 40 not to be subjected)
- 4. Programmes done will be joint activities of SMSIMSR & SCC either in Karnataka or in Telangana
- Collect LBC samples and test them for HPV with the help of PCR machines. We need two reagents for this and since it is inhouse, we will do the maximum service.
- 6. R&D projects to be taken up jointly once the Ethics committees of both organisations approve

Signed on this day 7th day of December month 2024 year on mutually agreed points and shall be valid for a period of 3 years initially and can be extended with mutual agreement there after.
